TOURNAMENT

League

- There will be 1 league of 12 teams.
- League name: Mighty League
- Kick offs: 6:10pm, 6:45pm and 7:20pm
- Single round robin.
- The team who comes top of the league are the winners.

Playoffs Leagues

- 3 leagues of 4 teams each (Champions League, Oxanforda League, Oxanforda Conference)
- Single round robin.
- The team who comes top of each playoff league are the winners.
- Kick offs: 6:10pm, 6:45pm and 7:20pm
- The below kick off times can be adjusted to suit teams.

Champions League

1st to 4th place teams – 6:10pm kick offs

Oxanforda League

5th to 8th place teams – 6:45pm kick offs

Oxanforda Conference League

9th to 12th place teams – 7:20pm kick offs

GAME RULES

Matches

- 8-a-side
- All games will have a duration of 30 minutes with 35-minute slots.

League

- 3 points will be awarded for a win.
- 1 point will be awarded for a draw.
- If teams have the same number of points, then goal difference will be used to determine league position.
- If teams have the same number of points and goal difference, then head to head will be used to determine the league position.
- If teams have the same points, goal difference, and the head to head was a draw, then goals for will be used to determine the league position.
- If teams have the same points, goal difference, goals for, and the head-to-head was a draw, then the team with the better disciplinary record will be used to determine the league position.



COVID-19 RISK ASSESSMENT

RULES

To ensure the safety of all our players we will be implementing the following rules.

- No bibs will be worn – every player will need to bring a light and dark top (all players in a team should have the same and if not possible similar colours).
- Every player must complete the [Covid-19 health check form](#) before attending the venue.
- Goalkeeper gloves cannot be shared.
- Players will need to arrive at earliest 15 mins before their team's kick-off time and cannot hang around the venue after their game has finished.
- No handshaking and social distancing must be adhered to when not playing.
- No spitting allowed.
- Balls will be regularly sanitised - anytime a different ball is used it will be sanitised.
- Infrared forehead thermometer will be used to take temperature on arrival before any exercise as exercise will increase your body temperature.
