TOURNAMENT

Leagues

- There will be 2 leagues of 8 teams (16 teams in total):
 - 1. Superstar League (7:10pm and 7:50pm kick-offs)
 - 2. Ultimate League (8:30pm and 9:10pm kick-offs)
- Single round robin.
- The team who comes top of each league are the winners.
- The teams in each league will qualify for playoff tournaments.

Playoffs Leagues

- 4 leagues of 4 teams each (Premiership, Division 1, Division 2, Conference)
- Double round robin.
- The team who comes top of each playoff league are the winners.
- Kick-off times will be 7:10pm, 7:50pm, 8:30pm and 9:10pm.

Oxford Premiership

 1^{st} and 2^{nd} place teams from League 1 (Superstar) and League 2 (Ultimate) – 7:10pm kick offs

Oxford Division One

 3^{rd} and 4^{th} place teams from League 1 (Superstar) and League 2 (Ultimate) – 7:50pm kick offs

Oxford Division Two

5th and 6th place teams from League 1 (Superstar) and League 2 (Ultimate) – 8:30pm kick offs

Oxford Conference

7th and 8th place teams from League 1 (Superstar) and League 2 (Ultimate) – 9:10pm kick offs

GAME RULES

Matches

- 6-a-side
- All games will have a duration of 35 minutes with 40-minute slots.

League

- 3 points will be awarded for a win.
- 1 point will be awarded for a draw.
- If teams have the same number of points, then goal difference will be used to determine league position.
- If teams have the same number of points and goal difference, then head to head will be used to determine the league position.
- If teams have the same points, goal difference, and the head to head was a draw, then goals for will be used to determine the league position.
- If teams have the same points, goal difference, goals for, and the head to head was a draw, then the team with the better disciplinary record will be used to determine the league position.



COVID-19 RISK ASSESSMENT

RULES

To ensure the safety of all our players we will be implementing the following rules.

- No bibs will be worn every player will need to bring a light and dark top (all players in a team should have the same and if not possible similar colours).
- Every player must complete the <u>Covid-19 health check form</u> before attending the venue.
- Goalkeeper gloves cannot be shared.
- Players will need to arrive at earliest 15 mins before their team's kick-off time and cannot hang around the venue after their game has finished.
- No handshaking and social distancing must be adhered to when not playing.
- No spitting allowed.
- Balls will be regularly sanitised anytime a different ball is used it will be sanitised.
- Infrared forehead thermometer will be used to take temperature on arrival before any exercise as exercise will increase your body temperature.
